Celeste 36 tested in 'Yacht' - Heyman Yachts

- 4 berths, 2 in the forepeak and 2 separate berths in the stern
- White painted mast and carbon fibre park avenue boom from Marstrom Composite (two spreaders)

- Rod rig, hydraulic backstay tensioner, gas spring kick, single line reef and German main sheet system, lazy jacks
- Harken Switch batt car system (meaning that the mainsail does not build height on the boom).
- Anchor lantern and tricolour in the masthead
- Loop light LED lantern for engine and deck lighting
- Electric Furlex (under deck) for the jib
- Thoroughly renewed and rigid running rigging
- 2 x electric mainsheet winches (Andersen 46 ST)
