- Sparcraft furling mast, main boom, and spinnaker boom
- Additional removable inner forestay mounted as a "Solent rig" with manually adjustable turnbuckle
- Standing rigging replaced in 2014 and upgraded to better wire and heavier-gauge components (forestay, backstay, lower shrouds, and top shrouds)
- Custom-made shroud screw protectors for top and lower shrouds in AISI 316L, 1200 mm high, 2022
- Facnor furling system for the genoa
- Sparcraft rod kick (gas springs replaced)
- The running rigging is partially replaced. (Main halyard, genoa halyard, and staysail halyard have been replaced; the gennaker halyard and spinnaker boom lift have not been replaced, but are fully functional and have seen little use.)
- The sail set consists of a mainsail (furling without battens), a 140% genoa, and a staysail on pistol hooks; all are sewn for cruising in heavy-duty Dacron fabric
- Gennaker ≈ 200 m² with a sock (very little use)
- All sails are Jekell Sails from 2014
